Jeremy's Key Budget and Taxpayer-Saving Accomplishments

- ▶ Lowered taxes a record four years to the lowest level in 15 years.
- ➤ Created the plan to dedicate \$28 million of property tax relief over the next 20 years from new CF Industries Revenue.
- Saved \$1.2 million in wasteful spending at Prairie Hills and reinvested savings in the County Jail and in historic preservation of the courthouse.
- Donated salary increases to the courthouse and law enforcement training center refusing a raise all four years, the only elected official to do so.
- ► Helped generate over \$100 million in economic development growth and by increasing cooperation with the City of Sioux City, gained \$13.9 million in economic development money for a \$72 million Reinvestment District.
